In 1991, a small group of health professionals established the Flagstaff Community Free Clinic, with the focus of providing resources to uninsured patients who were regularly going to the emergency room for care. In 1996, the clinic transitioned from a volunteer organization into a state and federally funded community health center.

Today, North Country HealthCare is a teaching health center that serves 11 rural communities across Northern Arizona, with a mission to ensure no one is without access to primary care.

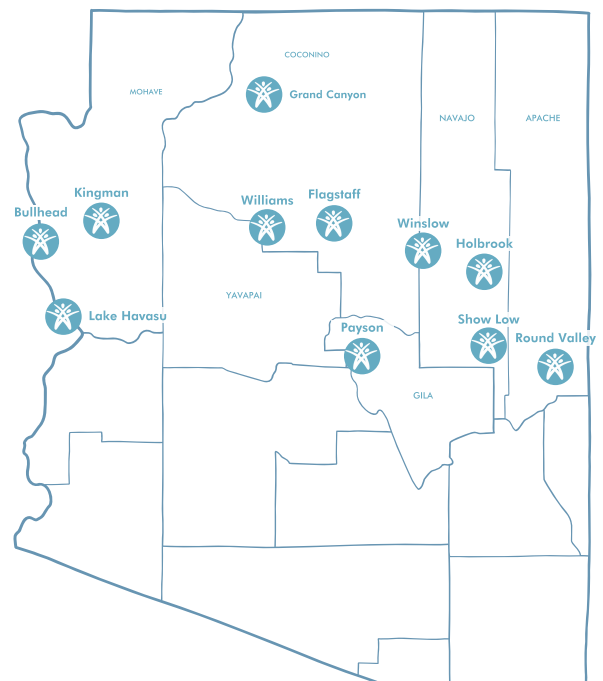
Patients include a mix of people with AHCCCS/Medicaid (38%), commercial insurance (30%), Medicare (23%), and no insurance. (9%).

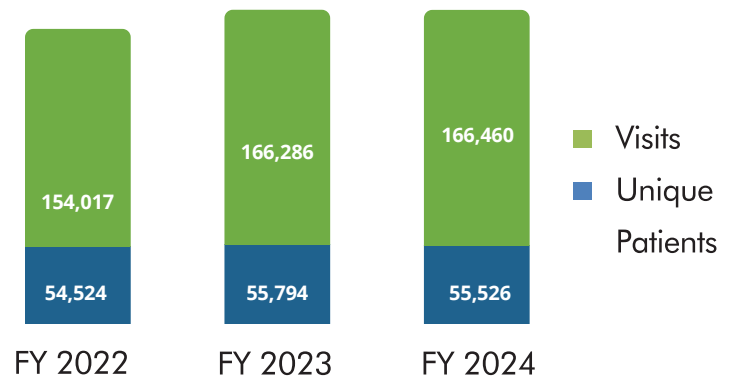
Governance

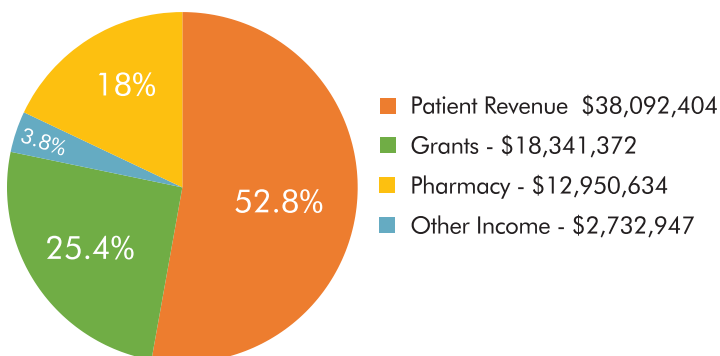
Mission
