
Future Health Careers and College

This project required a lot of research before we implemented our intervention. We were able to raise money for funding our invervention.


PARTICIPANTS


We went to Coconino High School and had 4 students the first week. Then we went to Flagstaff High School and we averaged about 50 students, between the last two weeks.



OBJECTIVES

- Process: Create pre- and post-tests to measure students' motivation and confidence.
- Process: Have guest speakers.
- Impact: Increase students educational awareness by a 33%
- Impact: 33% of students will fill out a college application.

THEORETICAL FRAMEWORK

For our intervention, we used the Social Cognitive Theory. This theory "emphasizes a bidirectional process of influence that includes: behaviors, personal factors, and environmental factors with each domain acting on and impacting each other" (McKenzie, 2023).

A high school students' behavioral capability, expectations, expectancies, self-efficacy, and emotional-coping responses all affect their attitudes and knowledge toward attending college for health related careers.

We utilized observational learning and reinforcement methods to keep the students engaged, as well as reciprocal determinism, by reaching out to guest speakers that are knowledgeable about health careers and the college enrollment processes to influence our students. Overall this theory helped provided us with expectations on how to achieve a change in the students behavior.
